Infants:

Our infant area provides the highest quality care in an environment that is designed with the parent and child in mind. While in our care, the children are stimulated through music, exercise, outdoor blanket time, facial and verbal mimicking as well as lots of hugs and tickles.

Toddlers:

At this age, children are meeting new challenges as fast as they come. Crawling, walking and eventually running are levels they accomplish in what seems like a blink of an eye. Children learn best if they are in stimulating environment. Music, stories, outdoor play, and learning simplicities envelop much of the day. Our caregivers are dedicated in helping each child develop these skills through a trusting and loving relationship. A parental daily report is given to update each family on meal times, nap times, toilet training and all activities accomplished each day.

Preschoolers:

There are seven Early Learning Developmental Donations – Physical Development, Approaches to Learning, Social and Emotional Development, Language and Literacy, Mathematical Thinking, Scientific Inquiry, Social Studies and Creative Expression Through the Arts. We incorporate all seven donations into our preschool curriculum. In addition, our preschool curriculum includes a Monthly Themed Daily Lesson Plan with Character Development, Faith-Based Scripture Memory, Circle Time, Music and Movement, Language and Literacy, Reading Readiness, Math and Manipulatives, Sensory and Science, Art and Fine and Gross Motor.

School-Age:

We offer Before and After School Care as well as Summer Camp for School Aged children.
